Today some of the young people from the youth group went out to one of the schools and put on a little show for about 2 dozen children. Tom said that there are more schools asking for people to come and do the same things for their students. Thank the Lord for the many open doors and also for the young people that are willing to be a part of these opportunities.

I heard the news today that Naim, Jorge, and Edwin—the three brothers here—will be meeting their new parents on July 23rd. You can pray for a smooth transition and for encouragement for Rosa, Alberto, and all the family here who will miss them greatly. The adopting family is from Lima, so there is the potential to keep in touch with them, and possibly even see the boys again in the future. There has also been talk of Solomon—the youngest member of our little family here—going to a new family this month. That will be an especially hard separation for Rosa and Alberto, although we are certainly thankful for the opportunities these children have to find “forever families”.
